Wandering or Stray Companion Animals

As a pet owner, you have a responsibility to keep your animal contained inside your property which means you need to have fencing that your pet can't jump over, dig under, push over or get through. If you don't have fencing, your pet must either be kept inside or in an enclosed space. Council has been receiving an increased amount of calls regarding wondering animals. If your pet is found "at large" and seized by Council, it may be taken to Council's animal holding facility, this will attract a \$330 penalty notice plus any impounding fees.

Registration must be completed before the animal is released to your care. You are also responsible for any feacal mess that your pet makes outside it's place of residence, a fine of \$275.00 is applicable for waste not immediately removed of and disposed of in an appropriate manner.

EDUCATOR'S WERE ABLE TO LINK THIS LEARNING BACK TO FAMILY INPUT OF CHILDREN RECENTLY VISITING THE DENTIST. SOME CHILDREN HAD PHOTO'S TO SHARE OF THEIR VISITS TO THE DENTIST. THIS WAS A GREAT OPPORTUNITY TO SHARE THEIR EXPERIENCE WITH THEIR PEERS. THIS AGE GROUP FURTHER EXTENDED THEIR LEARNING WITH A VISIT TO COLOMON SHIRE LIBRARY FOR A SPECIAL STORYTIME FOCUSED ON DENTAL HEALTH.

CHILDREN IN ALL AGE GROUPS PARTICIPATED IN AGE APPROPRIATE ACTIVITIES TO BEGIN THEIR LEARNING AND UNDERSTANDING OF HOW TO CARE FOR THEIR TEETH. OUR YOUNGER AGE GROUPS WERE ABLE TO EXPLORE USING A TOOTH BRUSH WITH TOOTH BRUSH PAINTING!
