#### Roads - Drive to the conditions

When driving a motor vehicle, truck or riding a motorcycle you are taking responsibility for your own safety and the safety of the people around you. Driving to the conditions means being aware of your surroundings and adapt your driving to suit those conditions.

During wet weather:

.

- Reduce your speed when there is increased water on the road.
  - In reduced visibility, turn your lights on. This increases your visibility to other road users.
  - Avoid harsh acceleration and sudden stops when driving on wet or compromised road surfaces such as: pot holes, uneven or slippery surfaces as this could result in loss of traction and possible loss of control of your vehicle.
  - Increase the distance between yourself and the vehicle in front of you. It takes longer to stop in the wet. Most importantly, reduce your speed, adhere to roadside warnings, and speed advisory signs, they are there for a reason.

If the road is wet, today is not the day to speed. Be aware of the speed you are travelling at and slow down!
