## Bin Etiquette & Your Collection

Bin etiquette and placement is an important part of waste management and helps keep everyone happy.

- · Place your bin/s out on the kerbside the evening before your collection day.
- · Please note: Garbage trucks stop frequently and to avoid unnecessary disruption to the service and danger to both motorists and the garbage collectors, certain roads with high traffic volumes may have their collection start before
- · Ensure lids are fully closed, as overfull bin/s may not be collected.
- · Do not place rubbish on top of or beside the bin/s.
- · Ensure your bin/s weighs less than 80kg +.
- · Space your bin 0.5m 1m apart from other bins.

Place your bin/s on clear ground in front of and abutting the kerb and gutter and away from any obstructions, such as vehicles, overhanging trees, electricity poles and letter boxes.

It is important that your bins are placed on the road in front of and abutting the kerb and gutter to ensure that the collection vehicle does not damage the road that abuts the lip of the kerb and gutter.

In areas with no kerb and gutter, place your bins in the road reserve abutting the edge of seal and where there is no seal, place your bin at the edge of road formation.

Residents are also reminded that unless additional services (extra bins) have been paid for and rated, that additional bins will not be collected by the collection contractor.

If you require an additional service of bin, please contact Council to make appropriate arrangements.

The garbage contractor has been instructed not to collect additional unauthorised services/bins.

# **Barking Dogs**

Pet ownership can be rewarding but it also has its responsibilities.

As an owner you have the responsibility to keep your pet fit, healthy and abide by the legislation, this includes registering your animals and ensuring they do not create a nuisance.

As a neighbour or resident of any community, individuals have the right to enjoy their amenity and not be annoyed by other peoples pets.

When animals cause nuisance by way of barking or wandering there are several options:

- The individual may contact the owner to discuss their concerns directly, this has the benefit of maintaining ghbourly relations, the owner may not realise their pet is bothering others in the area and take steps to
- · Should you be reluctant in approaching your neighbour, you are free to contact the Council to explain your concerns & Council will investigate the matter. Council have our own policies & procedures that include letters, investigations or visiting the neighbourhood. This may mean action taken against the owner.
- on some occasions after the investigation is carried out and Council can find no supporting evidence that justifies the concerns raised as a broad community concern, the individual may wish to pursue the matter civilly. To do this, the individual may contact the Community Justice Centre and work through the
